**Process:** The board nominating committee is charged, to the best of its ability, with taking into consideration the size of the company and disciplines in the industry to help ensure the board fully represents RSI membership. The nominees are vetted by the nominating committee and presented to the board of directors where a slate is cast. The RSI board then presents a slate of candidates to the full RSI membership for ratification at the RSI Annual Membership Meeting which held in conjunction with Railway Interchange 2019 in Minneapolis, Minnesota on September 22 – 24.

**Requirements**

- Nominee must be from a member company in good standing.
- Nominee must be a senior executive in their company and in a position to devote the necessary time and resources to support the organization.
