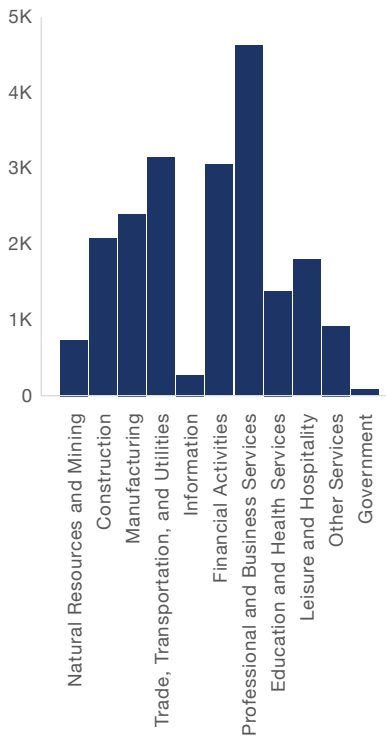

were sustained as employees spent their wages on consumer goods.

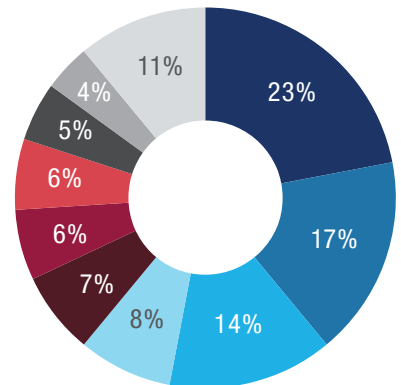

This was made up of \$290 million in federal taxes and \$129 million in state and local taxes.

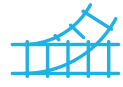
