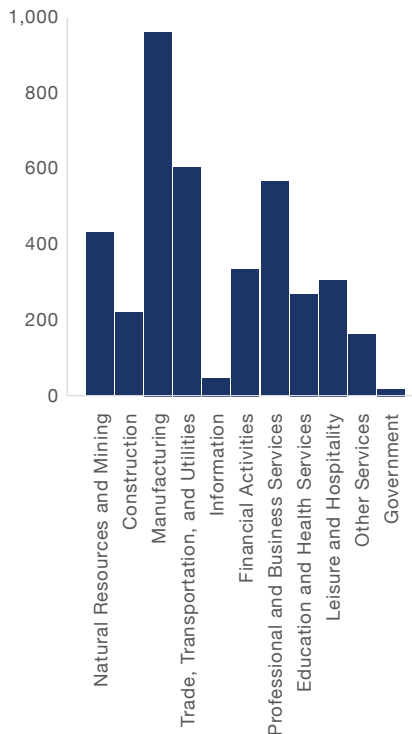

# 1,350 induced jobs

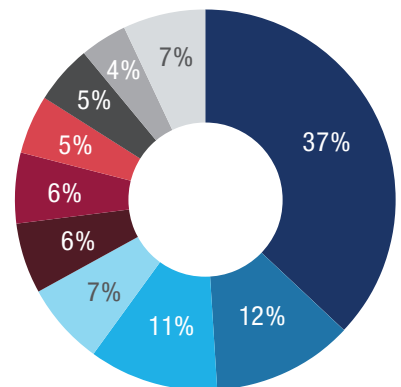
were sustained as employees spent their wages on consumer goods.
