

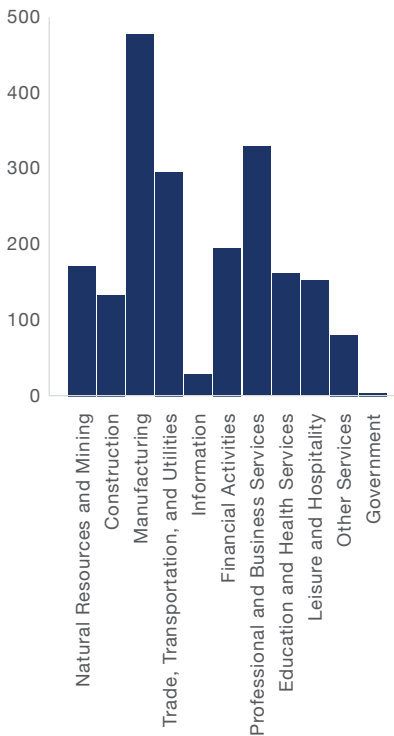

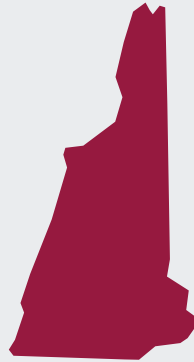


## 4.4 jobs

# \$168 million



In 2017, the railway supply industry directly employed **374** workers in New Hampshire.

On average, they earned **\$64,782** in annual income.

By comparison, the average worker in the U.S. earned approximately **\$55,400**

**840** indirect jobs supported through railway suppliers' supply-chain purchases.

**812** induced jobs were sustained as employees spent their wages on consumer goods.

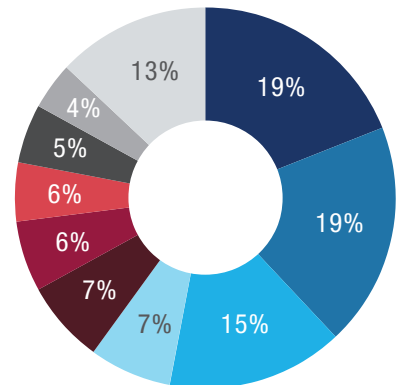

Tax contribution from the state of New Hampshire in 2017.

This was made up of **\$29 million** in federal taxes and **\$11 million** in state and local taxes.
