

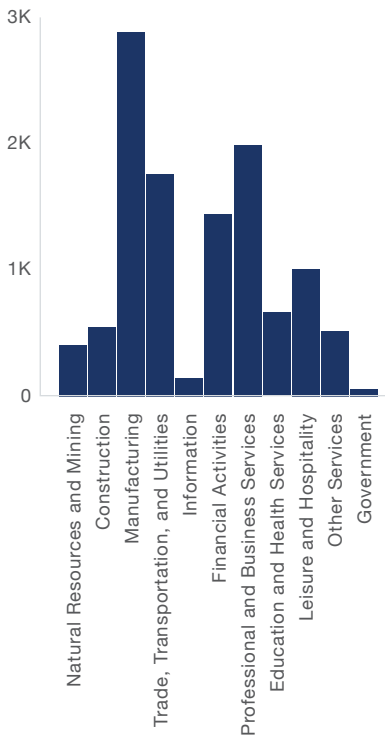

Additional jobs supported elsewhere in South Carolina's economy for every direct job in the state's railway supply industry.

CONTRIBUTION TO SOUTH CAROLINA'S GDP IN 2017

\$1.0 billion



In 2017, the railway supply industry directly employed **2,679** workers in South Carolina.

On average, they earned **\$65,989** in annual income.

By comparison, the average worker in the U.S. earned approximately **\$55,400**

4,803 indirect jobs supported through railway suppliers' supply-chain purchases.

4,026 induced jobs were sustained as employees spent their wages on consumer goods.

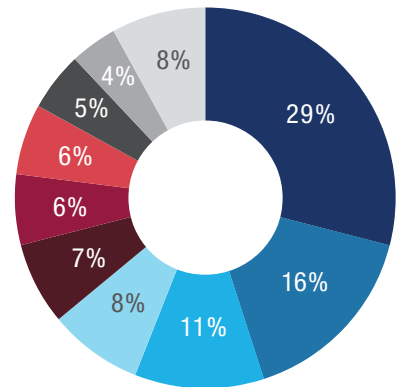

Tax contribution from the state of South Carolina in 2017.

This was made up of **\$156 million** in federal taxes and **\$81 million** in state and local taxes.
