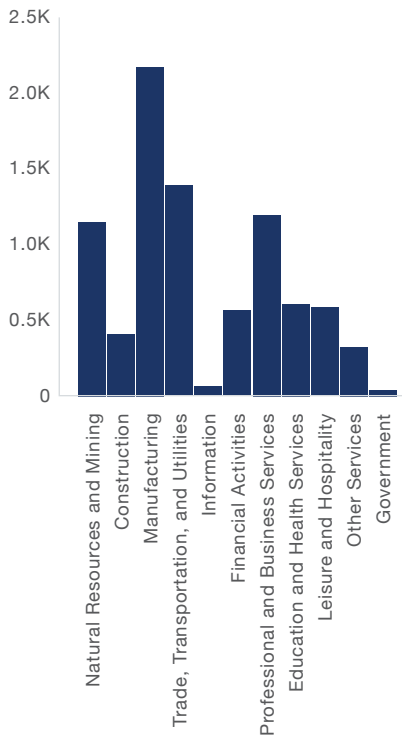

Additional jobs supported elsewhere in Arkansas's economy for every direct job in the state's railway supply industry.

CONTRIBUTION TO ARKANSAS' GDP IN 2017



\$766 million

In 2017, the railway supply industry directly employed

1,604

workers in Arkansas.

On average, they earned

\$54,265

in annual income.

By comparison, the average worker in the U.S. earned approximately **\$55,400**

3,920 indirect jobs

supported through railway suppliers' supply-chain purchases.

2,725 induced jobs

were sustained as employees spent their wages on consumer goods.

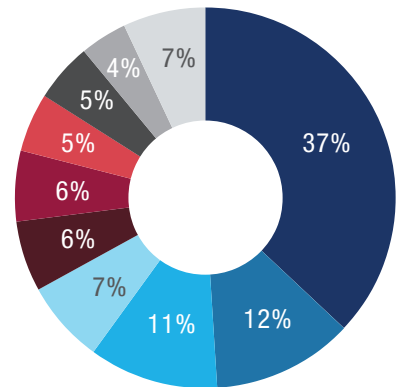

This was made up of **\$116 million** in federal taxes and **\$59 million** in state and local taxes.

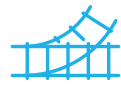
