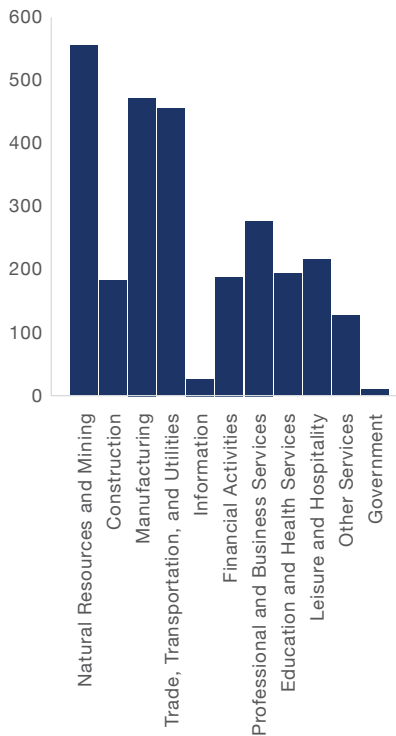

## TOTAL RAILWAY SUPPLY JOB IMPACT BY INDUSTRY IN MONTANA



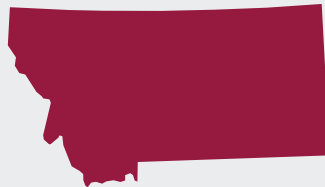

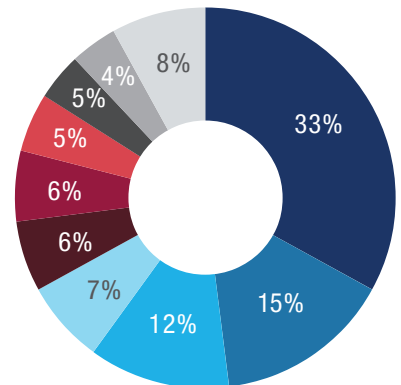
were sustained as employees spent their wages on consumer goods.
