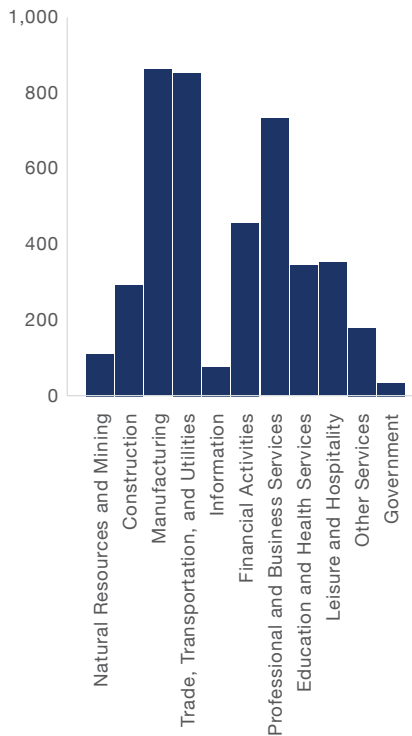


The railway supply industry helps to power Nebraska's economy.

## CONTRIBUTION TO NEBRASKA'S GDP IN 2017



**\$412 million**

In 2017, the railway supply industry directly employed **932** workers in Nebraska.

On average, they earned **\$62,498** in annual income.

By comparison, the average worker in the U.S. earned approximately **\$55,400**

**1,637** indirect jobs supported through railway suppliers' supply-chain purchases.

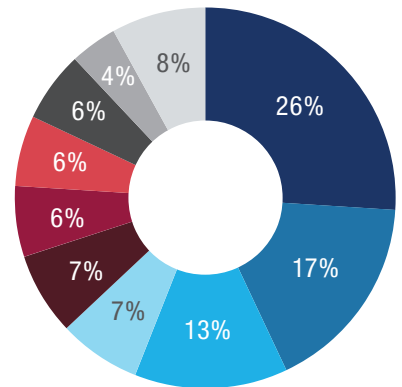
**1,729** induced jobs were sustained as employees spent their wages on consumer goods.

**\$90 million**

Tax contribution from the state of Nebraska in 2017.

This was made up of **\$64 million** in federal taxes and **\$27 million** in state and local taxes.
