

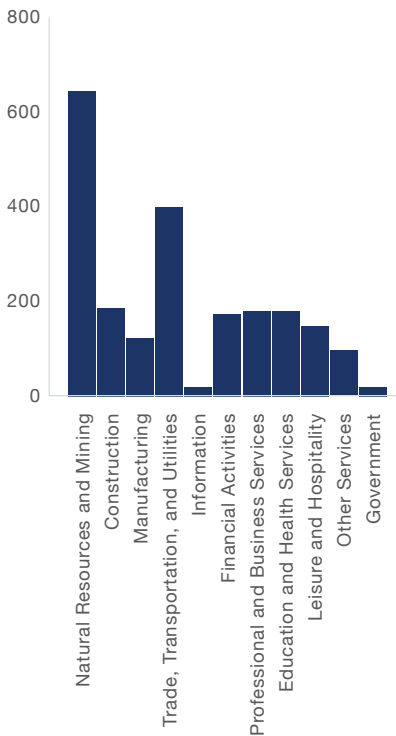

## TOTAL RAILWAY SUPPLY JOB IMPACT BY INDUSTRY IN NORTH DAKOTA



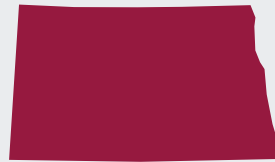

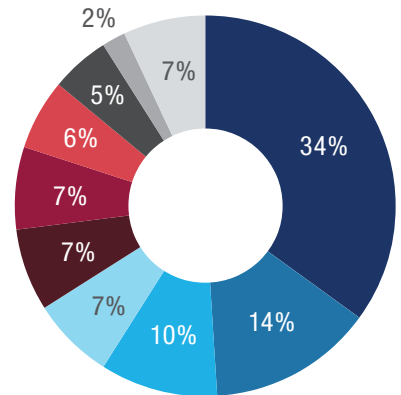
