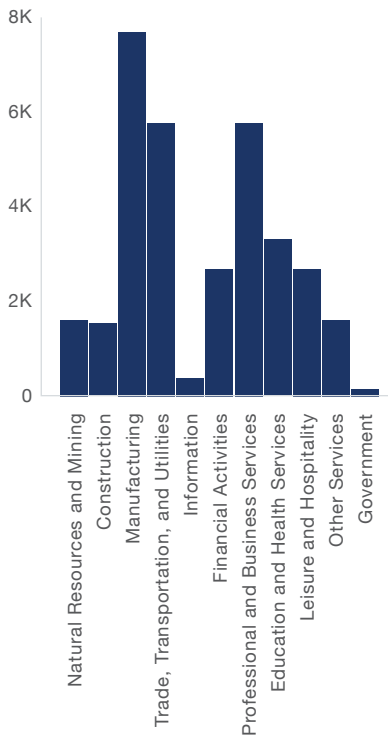


The railway supply industry helps to power Pennsylvania's economy.

Additional jobs supported elsewhere in Pennsylvania's economy for every direct job in the state's railway supply industry.

CONTRIBUTION TO PENNSYLVANIA'S GDP IN 2017



\$3.7 billion

In 2017, the railway supply industry directly employed **5,723** workers in Pennsylvania.

On average, they earned **\$83,366** in annual income.

By comparison, the average worker in the U.S. earned approximately **\$55,400**

13,944 indirect jobs supported through railway suppliers' supply-chain purchases.

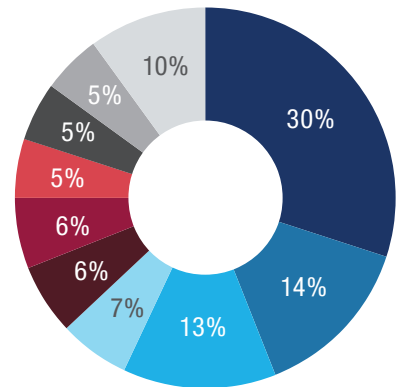
14,334 induced jobs were sustained as employees spent their wages on consumer goods.

Tax contribution from the state of Pennsylvania in 2017.

This was made up of **\$599 million** in federal taxes and **\$277 million** in state and local taxes.
