

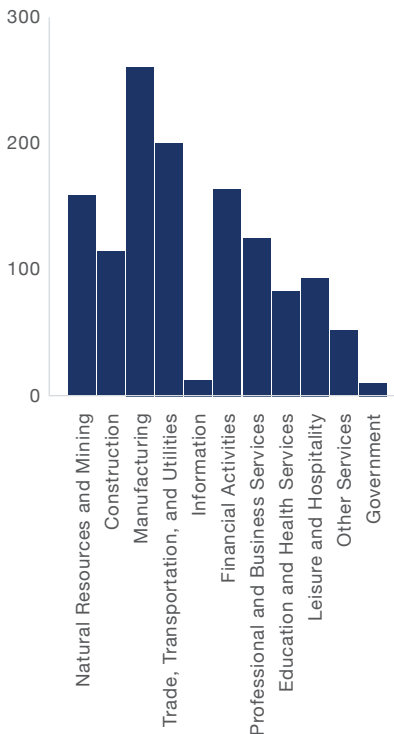

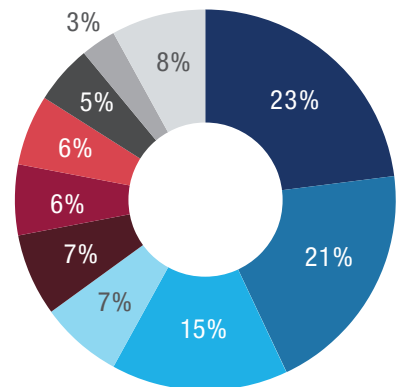

This was made up of \$16.3 million in federal taxes and \$5.2 million in state and local taxes.

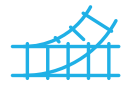
OCCUPATION PROFILE OF RAILWAY SUPPLIERS IN SOUTH DAKOTA
