

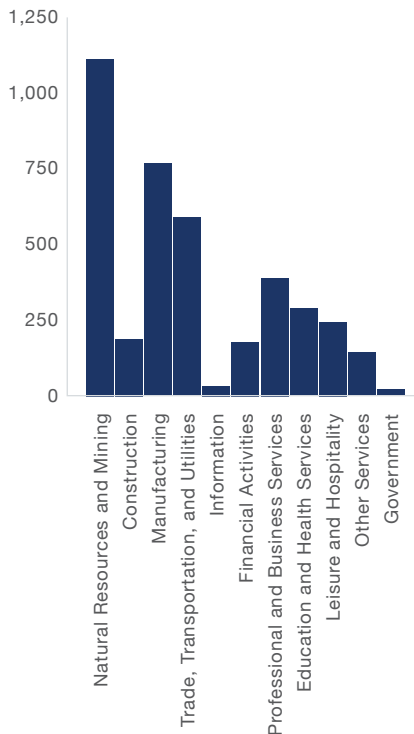

TOTAL RAILWAY SUPPLY JOB IMPACT BY INDUSTRY IN WEST VIRGINIA



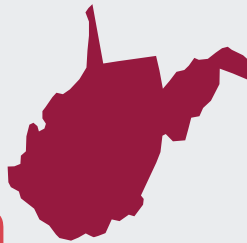

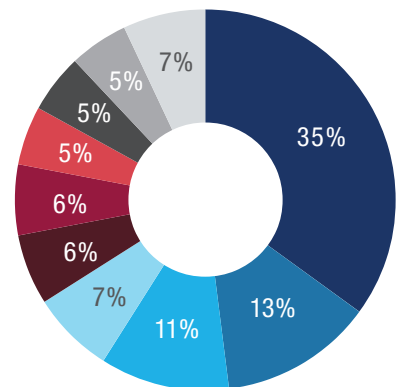
